

SAINT PROJECT REQUIREMENTS & HELPFUL TIPS

Saint projects are **due on May 5th! Each teen will share their project, as well as the information they have learned about their saint in their small group that day!**

Note: if the project will be presented electronically (like a powerpoint or video), please email it to me (sahearn@avemaria.church) by May 2nd!!!

At Ave, we love to give our confirmands a lot of creative freedom when it comes to saint projects. We want teens to interact with their saints in a way that inspires them! That being said, embarking on a super open-ended project can be really overwhelming! **Here are some ideas of projects we've seen, and LOVED from the past, to get the creative juices flowing!**

NOTE: You are not limited to the list below, they are just helpful ideas!

- A tri fold project with a photo of the saint, and information
- A video about the saint's life
- A painting of the saint
- A needle point embroidery (either on a piece of fabric, or an item of clothing) that reflects the saint (either a picture of them, or some sort of saint theme e.g. roses for St. Therese)
- A powerpoint about the saint
- A saint vision board

It is also important that teens demonstrate that they've really taken time to learn about the life of their saint. **Below are some questions that your child will need to be able to answer with their project. If your child is doing a presentation, or a video, they can easily answer the questions in that format. If your child is doing something like a song or an art-piece, they should bring a paper with the answers to go over during their presentation!**

Detailed Information about your saint:

- The saint's full name
- When and where was the saint born? or if the birthdate is not available, note time lived
- Saint's family, friends?
- What did they do in their earthly life? What is the Saint known for?
- What are some miracles that are attributed to them?
- What are they the patron saint of? (i.e. Saint Damian is the patron saint for doctors and Leprosy)
- When and how did they die?
- When is their feast day?

- Is there a shrine dedicated to this saint?

- Other information you find interesting about the saint. Important facts/information/details about the Saint.
