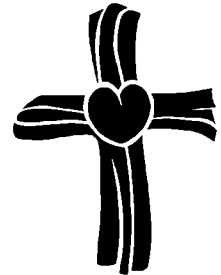


RCIA Dismissal & Inquiry Catechists and Aides needed

Children and Teen who wish to celebrate the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Communion and Penance need your guidance.

They are enrolled in the **Rite of Christian Initiation**.



It is essential that we have adults and/or teens willing to facilitate, aide or substitute for the sake of the children's faith formation and sacramental preparation.

- ◆ **What is the RCIA?** The RCIA is the process the world wide Church mandates for parish use to bring those who are asking to celebrate the sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).
- ◆ **What is RCIA Inquiry?** It is a series of lessons that introduce the children to the Church from Jan. Through May 1, 2015
- ◆ **What is RCIA Dismissal?** Dismissal is reflection on the scripture reading proclaimed during the 5PM liturgy after the homily until Mass is concluded. Aug. 23, 2015 through March 20, 2015. Meets? Same dates as children's Faith Formation
- ◆ **Why is this so Important?** Families arrive continuously throughout the year. They long to enroll children in Catholic Formation classes. We never turn them away, or say wait until the fall.
